No Loss Guarantee Program

It is clear that many chapters are concerned about hosting two day events. They do not want to risk the Chapter treasury on a seminar! We listened and are rolling out the "No Loss Guarantee" (NLG) again. To qualify for this optional program, chapters must accept the NLG program when booking the seminar and meet the following criteria:

- The NLG applies to two day seminars
- The registration fee for the two day event must be at least \$400 per registrant. If a chapter wants to offer discounts for members, the member price can be no lower than \$400. The non-member price can be higher with the price set by the chapter.
- The seminar should include refreshments in the morning, and for the mid-morning and afternoon breaks. Lunch should be provided.
- If the chapter can arrange for a free facility, then a free registration can be provided to the organization providing the facility.
- If a hotel or restaurant is used as a venue, Canaudit would like to ensure that the meeting costs (facility, meals and breaks) are reasonable. Meeting rooms should be priced at \$150 per day or less. Participant meals and refreshments should be \$50 per day or less per participant. In some areas, this may not be possible. If this is the case, contact Canaudit prior to confirming the facility. We will use our corporate purchasing power to reduce these costs or find an alternate acceptable facility.
- The chapter will provide a computer projector for use in the seminar
- Canaudit reserves the right to cancel the event if there are less than 12 paid registrants as of the cutoff date.
- Profits from NLG events, after deducting Canaudit's normal instructor fee and expenses, belong to the chapter.

Chapters in the NLG program that lose money must present Canaudit with profit and loss statement for the event within 15 days of the end of the seminar.
